If a word ends in the letters 'gn' the 'g' becomes silent. Example: <u>Lamb</u> > The b becomes silent so we pronounce the word lam. <u>Reign</u> > The g becomes silent so we pronounce the word rein.		<u>Starter</u> Lamb Comb Sign Reign	<u>Challenge 1</u> Thumb Numb Design Campaign	<u>Challenge 2</u> Align Assign Limb Plumb
