<b>Strengthen your learning</b>	Using a light, can you make different shadows? Can you make these look like animals? How have you made these shadows?	Can you create a toilet roll flower? What can you include in this? <b>Remember to ask your adult for permission and help with this.</b>	Can you draw your own hopscotch? How can you make this more challenging? Invite your family to have a go.
<b>Deepen your learning</b>	What is the difference between night and day? Why is there a difference between night and day? Create a poster about this. <b>*worth 10 reward points</b>	Can you create a paper mache flower pot? Decorate this with lots of colour <b>but remember to ask your adults help and permission</b> <b>*worth 20 reward points</b>	With your adult, can you bake buns for the people in your house? <b>Remember to ask your adult for permission and help with this.</b> <b>*worth 20 reward points</b>	Use the picture below to spell your name using yoga. Make the challenge even harder by spelling your middle and last name.

What makes them reflective? <b>*worth 20 reward points</b></p>	<p>Create an insect using natural materials you can find in your garden.  <b>*worth 50 reward points</b></p>	<p>Can you help someone in your family do a job? How did helping them make you feel? <b>*worth 10 reward points</b></p>	<p>How many lunges can you do in 1 minute? Ask your adult to time you. Can you improve your score throughout the week? <b>*worth 20 reward points</b></p>
