Next half term we will be looking at the human body, and our main focus will be the skeleton and muscles.

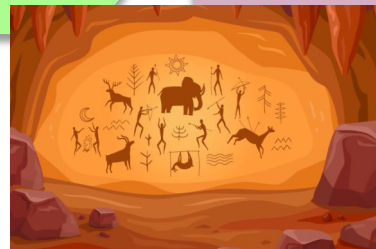
Some fun places to visit to help your child's learning are Magna and Eureka!
