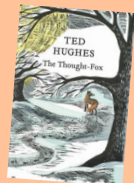
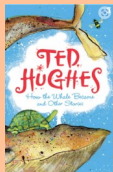
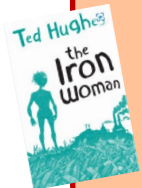
Reading
